THIS MONTH, PASTOR JAY FRAZELL would have celebrated 50 years as a called minister. In his memory, we will be taking up a special collection on TODAY, to be used according to his wishes in the Frazell Missionary Fund. He established the fund in 2013 to honor his parents.

TICKETS ARE NOW AVAILABLE for the gathering at the Lindenhof on Aug. 24. This is a 125th anniversary event to be held prior to the Dec. 8 celebration. The evening will start at 5:30 p.m. with some snack food followed by an authentic German meal at 6:30 (some American food will also be served). The menu

Food is served buffet style. Tickets will be sold beginning today and continue every Sunday until the end of July. **DID YOU KNOW?** – Rev. Jay Frazell attended Christ Lutheran School, went on to attend Concordia High School and College, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Theology. He earned his Master of Science Degree in Divinity from Concordia Seminary in 1969. After serving a Vicarage in Topeka, KS, he received his first call as pastor at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Valparaiso, IN. In 1974, Pastor Jay received a call as Chaplain of the International School of Hong Kong. He was later appointed an instructor for the Chinese Seminary. In 1980 he returned to the US to accept the position of pastor of Zion Lutheran Church in Bensonville, IN. After retiring in 2000, he served as pastor emeritus of various churches, CLC being among them. We were blessed to enjoy his gift of teaching and sharing the love of Jesus through his sermons and casual stories. Pastor Jay went to the loving arms of his Lord and Savior on April 25, 2019. We proudly celebrate one of our sons of the congregation on this his 50th anniversary of his ordination.
